**Periodic Test (10 marks)** – Three periodic tests will be conducted in the entire academic year and the average of best two will be taken. The weightage of periodic tests will be of 10 marks.

**Note Book Submission (5 marks)** - Notebook submission as a part of internal assessment is aimed at enhancing seriousness of students towards preparing notes for the topics being taught in the classroom as well as assignments. This also addresses the critical aspect of regularity, punctuality, neatness and notebook upkeep.

**Subject Enrichment Activities (5 marks)**-These are subject specific application activities aimed at enrichment of the understanding & skill development. These activities will be conducted by respective subject teachers and will have a weightage of 5 marks per subject for each term.

**Co-Scholastic Activities-** Co curricular activities are designed to promote holistic development of the students. These activities will be graded on a 5-point grading scale (A – E) and will not have descriptive indicators. No upscaling of grades will be done. The aspect of regularity, sincere participation, output and teamwork will be the generic criteria for grading in the following co-scholastic activities:

- a) Work Education (Computer Application and Operation)
- b) Art Education (Visual and Performing Art includes Art/Music/Dance)
- c) Health and Physical Education(Sports/Yoga)

**Discipline:** The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like sincerity, behavior, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others. Grading on Discipline will be done on a five points scale (A to E).
